Bedfordshire

Bedfordshire comprises of wonderful countryside - Downs, Chiltern Hills, Greensand Ridge and Marston Vale, delightful towns and villages - Woburn, Harrold, Sharnbrook and Oakley, great places to eat, drink and shop, impressive stately homes - Wrest Park and Woburn Abbey and plenty of attractions - Shuttleworth Collection, Swiss Garden, Whipsnade Zoo, Woburn Safari Park and Centre Parcs, to appeal to all tastes and ages.

If you do want to get away for a short break then there are excellent transport links. Trains to London take less than an hour at the weekends and are even quicker during the week and there is also a direct train to Brighton. The nearest coast by car is Norfolk (approximately 2 hours) which has an array of beautiful seaside villages and towns including Wells-next-the-sea and Blakeney.



Bedford River Festival

If you like walking or cycling then there are plenty of footpaths and cycle ways through beautiful countryside. There are also excellent outdoor sport facilities on the river Great Ouse.

The Priory County Park is a centre of educational activities for children of all ages. The lakes are well suited to fishing and water sports whilst bird lovers can take a stroll through the park.

Bedfordshire is also host to many entertaining cultural events - Carnival and Mela in Luton, the Riverside Festival in Bedford and Canal Festival in Linslade.



Buckinghamshire

Buckinghamshire is a hugely attractive region with beautiful countryside and plenty of opportunities for sightseeing and shopping.

Bicester Village offers excellent savings on a range of designer goods and for the complete shopaholic try thecentre:mk with over 240 shops it is the biggest shopping centre in the region!

Towns within the county include Aylesbury, High Wycombe, Amersham and Milton Keynes, all of which enjoy good transport links to London (roughly 1 hour by train) and some of the best schools the UK has to offer. Beautiful hamlets and small villages also scatter the county, where you will find fantastic gastro pubs.
